

Briefing for Directors and Engineers

We're using Narrafix to streamline our editing workflow with roll recordings and reduce manual work. To help the software perform at its best and minimize unnecessary manual effort later, we'd be truly grateful if you could go through the following guidelines with the narrator beforehand and keep them in mind during the session.



Mistakes? 1-2 Sec Pause – Then Start Again!

If a mistake happens, please advise the narrator to silently restart the sentence or passage **after a small pause of a second** or more. Please ask the narrator to avoid off-script comments like „I'll do that again“.



Avoid to Record Off-Script Speech

When discussing with the director/engineer, please simply **pause the recording**. Also, please ask the narrator to try to **respond to small directors comments silently** like nodding and to avoid off-script comments like „OK“ or „I'll do that again“.



Long Pauses or Interruptions

For extended interruptions (disturbances, phone calls, research, etc.), **please stop the recording** or remove the pause.



Do Not Add Acoustic Edit Markers

The files should **not contain any acoustic markers** (clicks, snaps, etc.). Visual edit markers in the session project file are also not necessary and will be ignored.
